- **Interaction with aviation leaders** from the nationally renowned FAA William J. Hughes Technical Center; and
- **Funding and outreach opportunities**

Seven applicants will be accepted for the 2021 program, which will be conducted virtually over a three-month period.

FlightPlan graduates are eligible to apply for small grants assisting with research on Smart Airport technologies and/or consistent with FAA research goals.
